

We immediately headed out to pick her up and took her straight to the emergency clinic. It appeared she had been struck by a car and needed her right hind leg amputated to prevent further infection and injury. Thanks to a quick Facebook fundraiser and your generosity, we were able to raise the needed funds for her surgery. She returned to the shelter, where she was placed into a playpen to facilitate her healing and to help her get her strength back. Within weeks, she was walking around and to our amazement, even jumping onto chairs, desks and bookshelves. She even became our official "receptionist!"
